MOTORCYCLE PARKING PLACES

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Westminster City Council proposes to make the following 3 Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended:

- The City of Westminster (Motorcycle Parking Places) (No. *) Order 200*;
- The City of Westminster (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. *) Order 200*; and
- The City of Westminster (Parking Places) (Further Provisions) (No. *) Order 200*;

2. The general effect of the proposed Orders would be to revoke and re-enact the following experimental Orders so as to continue in force indefinitely the formal designation of motorcycle parking areas in the City including charges for their use:

- The City of Westminster (Motorcycle Parking Places) (No. 1) Experimental Traffic Order 2008 (and any relevant amendments); and
- The City of Westminster (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (No. 2) Experimental Traffic Order 2008.

3 The proposed Orders will provide that:

- (a) the operational hours at the designated motorcycle parking places (the period during which the parking places will be available for the leaving of motorcycles only) will be as specified in column 3 of the table in the Schedule to this Notice;
- (b) the charging hours at the motorcycle parking places will be as specified in column 4 of the table in the Schedule to this Notice;
- (c) payment of the parking charge at all motorcycle parking places must be made through the Council's "pay by phone" service provider. User instructions and information will be displayed in the vicinity of each motorcycle parking place and on the Council's website:
www.westminster.gov.uk/transportandstreets/parking.
- (d) the charge for leaving a motorcycle in a motorcycle parking place during the charging hours (other than for residents' permit holders) will be as follows:

Daily charge	£1.00
Weekly charge	£3.50
Monthly charge	£13.50
Quarterly charge (3 months)	£33.50
Annual charge	£100.00

Please note that:

- there will be no further charge if a motorcyclist moves to any other motorcycle bay in the City once payment has been made;
 - there will be no charge for electric motorcycles, provided that they have been registered with the Council's service provider.
- (e) Westminster residents may apply to the Council for a resident's permit to be issued in respect of a motorcycle at a charge of £50 per year. The permit will allow the permit holder to leave the motorcycle at:
- any residents' or "shared use" parking space within the controlled parking zone in which they reside; and
 - any motorcycle parking place within the City.

4. The proposed Orders and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders are available for inspection until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at:
