



Westminster City Council proposes to make the following 3 Orders to be called:

- The City of Westminster (Motorcycle Parking Places) (No. *) Order 200*;
- The City of Westminster (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. *) Order 200*;
and
- The City of Westminster (Parking Places) (Further Provisions) (No. *) Order 200*;

The general effect of the proposed Orders would be to continue in force indefinitely the formal designation of motorcycle parking areas in the City including charges for their use.

The charge for leaving a motorcycle in a motorcycle parking place during the charging hours (other than for residents' permit holders) will be as follows:

Daily charge	£1.00
Weekly charge	£3.50
Monthly charge	£13.50
Quarterly charge (3 months)	£33.50
Annual charge	£100.00

Please note that:

- there will be no further charge if a motorcyclist moves to any other motorcycle bay in the City once payment has been made;
- there will be no charge for electric motorcycles, provided that they have been registered with the Council's service provider.

Westminster residents may apply to the Council for a residents' permit to be issued in respect of a motorcycle at a charge of £50 per year. The permit will allow the permit holder to leave the motorcycle at:

- any residents' or "shared use" parking space within the controlled parking zone in which they reside; and
- any motorcycle parking place within the City.
