Work Update

Morland House:

- The scaffold to Morland House has now been dismantled.
- Internal communal windows have now been decorated.
- Final internal decorations will not be completed until all residents have allowed access in to their
 properties to install the lateral mains connection. We can then go ahead with the flooring and final
 decoration paint coatings.
- Door entry systems again require access to all properties before this work is completed.
- External window works will be completed by the end of April 2022. It wasn't completed beforehand due to scaffold obstruction.
- Drainage works have commenced and will be completed by 4th April 2022.
- Front Entrance Doors: Ongoing liaison with conservation and planning departments. We will update you as soon as we have more information.

Maclise House:

- Scaffold will be dismantled by 15th April 2022 or before, weather permitting.
- Internal communal windows have been decorated.
- Final internal decorations will not be completed until all residents have allowed access in to their
 properties to install the lateral mains connection. We can then go ahead with the flooring and final
 decoration paint coatings.
- Door entry systems again require access to all properties before this work is completed.
- Ground floor external window works will be completed by the end of April 2022 when all scaffolding has been dismantled.
- Front Entrance Doors: Ongoing liaison with conservation and planning departments. We will update you as soon as we have more information.

Mulready House:

- Roof repairs completed.
- We will commence dismantling the scaffold from 11th April 2022. We will need to complete some decorations to the concrete and gutters as this comes down.
- Window repairs and decorations will be completed by 8th April 2022.
- Internal communal window decorations are underway.
- Final internal decorations will not be completed until all residents have allowed access in to their properties to install the lateral mains connection. We can then go ahead with the flooring and final decoration paint coatings.
- Door entry systems again require access to all properties before this work is completed.
- Ground floor external window works will be completed when all scaffolding has been dismantled.
- Front Entrance Doors: Ongoing liaison with conservation and planning departments. We will update you as soon as we have more information



Continued work update

Millais House:

- Roof repairs have commenced and are ongoing.
- We are due to begin dismantling the scaffold on 5th May 2022.
- Final internal decorations will not be completed until all residents have allowed access in to their properties to install the lateral mains connection. We can then go ahead with the flooring and final decoration paint coatings.
- Door entry systems again require access to all properties before this work is completed.
- Window repairs are progressing well.
- Ground floor external window works will be completed when all scaffolding has been dismantled.
- Front Entrance Doors: Ongoing liaison with conservation and planning departments. We will update you as soon as we have more information.

Reynolds House:

- External brickwork repairs are progressing well.
- Roof repairs will commence in April.2022.
- External window works will be completed when all scaffolding has been dismantled.
- Front Entrance Doors: Ongoing liaison with conservation and planning departments. We will update you as soon as we have more information.
- Flats 27-52 are still awaiting planning consent.

Hogarth House:

- Scaffold is ongoing and we aim to have this up by 18th April 2022 weather permitting.
- The lateral mains containment is ongoing.

Gainsborough House:

- We anticipate the scaffold start date to be 25th April 2022 weather permitting. We have written to all residents of Gainsborough house inviting them to an on-line team's session on 12th April 2022 to discuss works in there block.
- Drainage works are now complete in and around flats 31-60.
