Site Team



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Works to date

Works are progressing well. We have a dedicated site team and very accommodating residents which is extremely important when carrying out any major works. We would like to thank you all for your support and cooperation so far.

Scaffold: Construction of the scaffolding is complete at Elmton Court and we have now moved on to Hucknall Court. Hucknall Court scaffold is now complete and we will move on to Helsby Court after first notifying you.

External Works: These works will soon be commencing at Elmton Court. The work includes walkway repairs (preparation, repairs and coating of the walkway with anti-slip Bauder product). There will be minimum disruption to residents while applying the anti-slip product. One side of the corridor will be applied at a time, so as not to affect resident access. This area will be clearly signed. External fabric repairs (repairs to defective brickwork and concrete). Roof repairs and roof clean, subject to survey. Repairs and cleaning of rainwater goods, subject to survey. Replacement windows. Once the scaffolding is complete at Hucknall Court we will start the external surveys.

Drainage: Underground drainage is complete to Hucknall, Helsby, Birch Vale, Rothley, Pennyford, Cheadle and Ashby Courts.

Window Surveys: Surveys at Elmton Court are now complete and the window installations have commenced.

Electrical Works: We have commenced work in the communal areas of Elmton Court. We will be in touch soon, to book the in-flat works appointments with you. Hucknall Court communal electrical works will commence on 19th May 2022, again we will be in touch when we require access to your property.

Front Entrance Door and Communal Redecoration Colour Choice Form

As part of the planned major works at Wharncliffe Gardens, United Living will be replacing tenant front entrance doors (including those leaseholders that have opted in) and redecorating the communal areas of your block

In order for you to choose the colour combination of your choice we will shortly be sending you a ballot form to choose, sign, date and return in the pre-paid envelope provided.
