As part of our commitment to improving fire safety in your home we are planning on carrying out carry out fire safety works at Scott Ellis Gardens and Bronwen Court.

This letter includes important information about the planned work, the next steps and how to find out more information or ask questions.

What does the work include?

The work includes:

- Replacement or upgrade of tenant front entrance doors to ensure they are of a standard to stop the spread of fire for 30 minutes. Leaseholders will be offered an opt in for this work.
- Replacement or upgrade of communal fire doors.
- Fire stopping work to areas between homes to stop the spread of smoke or flames if there is a fire.
