As part of these works, we will be replacing the windows and carrying out external repairs to your block. In order for us to do this, we will need to place a scaffold around the building.

We will begin erecting the scaffold tower your block, the week commencing 28 February 2021.

Before the works start, we would like to remind you to contact your contents insurance provider to inform them that works are being carried out and there will be scaffolding around your block. This should not normally affect your premium.

Scaffolding should only be accessed by United Living staff. Please ensure pets and children do not play beneath or attempt to climb the scaffold, as this could result in serious injury.

Should you notice anyone on the scaffold outside of our working hours, please do not hesitate to call the police. Our access ladders will be removed, and access hatches locked.

We remain committed to protecting our clients, their residents and our employees by safely completing all our work in line with Government guidelines.
