Work Update

Works are currently running inline with the revised programme. The finish date being 23rd February 2022. (This allows approximately 4 weeks for the scaffold to be dismantled).

Current activities

Cladding: The primary function of cladding is to split the indoor environment of a building from the outside in such a way that the outdoor environment will not affect the indoors. It is also useful for regulating the light penetration and controlling the radiation and conduction of heat from the sun. There are a number of stages or layers that form the basis of the new system. These are made up of galvanised aluminium, a waterproof membrane and Insulation board. We are now 50% complete. (Floors 21 to 22 will be more complex).

A section of the newly installed cladding system will be used as a quality benchmark for Westminster City Council to approve.

The site notice board is updated on a daily basis for your convenience.
