## **Work Update**

Works are currently running inline with the revised programme (Subject to change).

## Activities that were completed last month were:

- Scaffold erection complete.
- Hoist in place.

## Activities planned for the next 4 weeks (subject to changes):

- Scaffold wrapping (this creates a temporary barrier around a scaffold, providing weather protection and environmental containment, enabling contractors to avoid delays caused by changes in weather).
- Debris netting to be fitted to hoist.
- Temporary electrics to the scaffolding.
- Insulation of internal sprinkler riser.
- Stripping of cladding.
- Fire stopping.
- In-flat sprinkler works.

Look out for United Living posters displayed in your block, informing you of impending works.
