Notice of Poll and Situation of Polling Stations

Neighbourhood Plan Referendum for the Belgravia Neighbourhood Area

1. A referendum will be held on **Thursday, 22nd February 2024** to decide on the question below:

“Do you want Westminster City Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Belgravia to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

2. The hours of poll will be from 7am to 10pm.
3. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, 14th Floor Westminster City Hall, 64 Victoria Street, London, SW1E 6QP** by **5pm on Thursday 22 February 2024**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on 14 February 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service reasons, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on 14 February 2024. An emergency proxy may also be applied for on grounds relating to voter identification - further information on this provision can be provided by Electoral Services: electoralservices@westminster.gov.uk.
4. The situation of the polling station and description of persons entitled to vote there are as follows:
