DEMOLISHING CARLTON DENE

We are pleased to announce that we have completed the demolition of phase of the former Carlton Dene Care Home. We will now be moving on the next phase of the construction activity which will involve conducting ground investigation works to identify any obstructions to prevent foundations from being laid and piling.

The next phase to the construction activity is scheduled to commence in October 2023. Lovell have over 50 years' experience as an affordable homes builder and will be delivering both phases of the new development.

SECTION 96A APPLICATION AT CARLTON DENE AND PEEBLES HOUSE

Following the grant of planning permission in March 2022 for the redevelopment of Carlton Dene care home, we have submitted a Section 96A planning application for non-material amendments to the permitted scheme. The submission includes light touch adjustments to the design to ensure it is compliant with up-to-date Building Regulations in addition to converting the scheme to 100% social rent following the launch of Westminster's Truly Affordable Housing Programme.

The development will still deliver:

- 65 self-contained extra care homes for older people on the site of Carlton Dene
- 22 family-sized apartments for social rent on the site of Peebles House
- extra care residents will have their own private balconies, in addition to a shared green space
- local older people will be able to apply first for the extra care housing if they wish
- residents will gain access to both a brand-new café and hairdressers
- a greener site, with landscaping and spaces for children

The redevelopment of Carlton Dene, Westmead and Beachcroft Homes are part of a wider council strategy dating back to 2007 known as Specialist Housing Strategy for Older People Programme (SHSOP), which shows the increasing demand for Extra Care housing in the City.

TORRIDON HOUSE

We have successfully completed the outside structure of the new housing block and we will continue with the completion of the town houses. Our contractors Osborne have also been busy engaging with the local community and recently supported St Augustine's school with mock interviews.

WE ARE OPENING FOUR NEW HOUSING SERVICE CENTRES

The first of four new Housing Service Centres was officially opened on Monday 5 June on the Mozart estate in Queen's Park. Residents are able to drop in and speak face-to-face with the housing team about a range of issues including repairs and maintenance, or seek advice if they need support with paying their bills. The centre on the Mozart Estate, Bruckner Street, in Queen's Park was the first initial rollout and three further facilities in Pimlico, Bayswater and Soho will be opened in the coming months ensuring residents across the borough benefit from the support our housing team has to offer.
