

# Ward Profiles



## Introduction

The **Ward Profiles** provide a range of demographic and population related data for each ward in Westminster and present key summary measures for the most recent year. They are designed to provide an overview of the population in these small areas by presenting a range of data on the population, diversity, deprivation, benefits, crime, digital exclusion, residents' satisfaction and concerns, health, wellbeing, land use, environment and socio-economic issues. The latest update for the ward profiles in 2022 is based on recent data from Westminster services, partner and external data sources, the 2022 City Survey, as well as the 2021 Census to offer a rounded view of Westminster's local communities.

## Guidance on visuals

The interactive report aims to enable users to visualise and assess local data with greater ease. The user can shape the information displayed on the page by using filters, as well as buttons or chart content. Multiple selection can also be made, for example two or more wards, by holding down the 'Ctrl' button and selecting the categories of interest.

If the user wishes to extract the raw data from a visual, then that's possible by following the steps:

- Select More options (...) from the upper-right corner of the visualisation.
- Choose the Export data option.
- Power BI exports the data to a .csv file. If the user has filtered the visualisation, then the .csv export will be filtered as well.

If the user wishes to use the visuals in a report, they can either use the snipping tool, print screen or export the pages as a PDF document. The latter is possible by following the steps:

- Select Export from the top left of the browser page.
- Choose the PDF option.
- PBI exports the pages to PDF file. If the user has got filters applied throughout the dashboard, then the PDF export will be filtered as well.




Total Population

Concentration of Residents, 2022








Top 5 Languages Spoken at Home (Excluding English), Census 2021\*



Ethnicities, Census 2021




To what extent do you agree or disagree that this local area (within 15 to 20 mins walking distance) is a place where people from different backgrounds get on well together? (City Survey, 2022)













The information on this page comes from LIFT, the low-income family tracker. This is a database which holds information about households who receive council tax support or housing benefit. Households in receipt of benefits that do not include council tax support or housing benefit are not included.

### Households in financial difficulties in LIFT definitions:

**In crisis** - When a household's take home income is not enough to meet just its rent and its council tax bill (i.e. at risk of arrears/eviction).

**At risk** - A household is identified as being "At risk" if its take home income is less than its expected costs, and it does not have enough savings to meet 3 months' worth of its expected costs.

**Struggling** - A household is identified as "Struggling" if its take home income is less than £100 over its expected costs (i.e. only just about enough to meet its costs) and it does not have 3 months' worth of savings.

**Coping** - If after costs are deducted, a household still has over £100 left over, it is identified as 'Coping'. Alternatively, if its remaining income is under £100 (and even negative) but it does have 3 months' worth of savings, it will also be classed as "Coping".

Any household that is 'not coping' or in financial difficulties is in one of the first three categories. Any household that is defined as not coping because its income is not enough to meet its outgoings **but** that has 3 months' worth of savings will be placed in the 'Coping' category.

Income and cost are calculated using monthly figures.






Number of crimes by Ward, London Datastore, 2023










How do you personally access the internet at home or at work? (City Survey 2021)




Thinking about the most confident person who uses the internet in your household (including yourself), how confident would you say they are? (City Survey 2022)






Overall, how satisfied are you with your life nowadays?


Overall, how anxious did you feel yesterday?




















Average Proportion of Fuel Poor Households

Concentration of Housing Benefits Claimants by Ward, May 2023




Universal Credit Claimants by Ward, July 2023


Concentration of households in Fuel Poverty by Ward (%), 2021






Economic Activity Status, Census 2021


Concentration of Unemployment (exc. students) by Ward, 2021




