

## Notice of Poll and Situation of Polling Stations

Neighbourhood Plan Referendum for the Queen's Park Neighbourhood Area

1. A referendum will be held on **Thursday 21 October 2021** to decide on the question below:

"Do you want Westminster City Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Queen's Park to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?"

- 2. The hours of poll will be from 7am to 10pm.
- 3. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, 14<sup>th</sup> Floor Westminster City Hall, 64 Victoria Street, London, SW1E 6QP by 5pm on Thursday 21 October. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 13 October. To apply on the grounds of work/service reasons, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 13 October.
