## Information for bars, clubs and restaurants

The Soho Angels are a team of volunteers helping people stay safe after a night out.

Our Angels offer anything from water and directions, to helping people contact friends and family or sitting with them while they sober up.

The Angels patrol Soho every Friday and Saturday night 10pm - 5am, looking out for anyone who needs support. They run a Night Hub on Dean Street where people can sober up, charge their phone or get medical help from St John Ambulance.

### When to contact an Angel?

#### When a vulnerable person...

- Needs a place to sit and sober up
- Is lost, or has lost their belongings
- Is upset and needs someone to talk to
- · Needs basic first aid

- Is alone and needs help contacting friends or family
- Has had a bad experience, is distressed or needs someone to talk to
- Needs a place to charge their phone so they can get home safely

If someone needs emergency medical attention always call an ambulance.
