Sussex Gardens W.2) unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 hereby direct that the permission granted by article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the description set out in the Schedule hereto

SCHEDULE

The erection or construction of gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure not exceeding one metre in height where abutting on a highway used by vehicular traffic, or two metres in height in any other case and the maintenance improvement or other alteration of any gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure where such improvement or alteration does not increase the height above the height appropriate for a new means of enclosure being development comprised within paragraph 1 of Class II

referred to in Schedule I to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other Class


