

Town and Country Planning Act 1990 Acquisition of Land Act 1981 The City of Westminster (Tollgate Gardens Estate, NW6) Compulsory Purchase Order 2014

WHEREAS the City of Westminster have submitted to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government/Business, for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 226(1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and the Acquisition of Land Act 1981, which would authorise them to acquire compulsorily the land referred to in the Schedule hereto for the purpose facilitating the carrying out of development, re-development and improvement on or in relation to the land for the provision of up to 248 new residential dwellings, replacement community facility, new public open spaces, improvements to pedestrian, cycle and highway facilities.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public local inquiry into this matter will be held by Tim Wood BA(Hons) BTP MRTPI at the 17th floor meeting rooms at City Hall, 64 Victoria Street, London SW1E 6QP on 9 June 2015 at 10 a.m.
