We would like to continue to support the community with events, but we need your input, if you have any ideas for events in the new year. Please email westmead@westminster.gov.uk




PROJECT UPDATE

NAMING THE NEW BUILDING

We would like to invite the local community to participate in selecting the name for the new development.

After consulting with our local councillors, we have shortlisted three names, with some honouring individuals who made significant historic contributions to our community:

Alcindor Apartments – Named after Dr. John Alcindor, a renowned physician and activist from Trinidad. He helped countless wounded soldiers at London railway stations as they returned from the battlefields. Deservedly, he was later awarded a Red Cross Medal for his life-saving work.

Westmead Apartments – Reflecting the historical significance of the site.

Ardizzone House – Edward Jeffrey Irving Ardizzone was a British painter, printmaker and war artist, and the author and illustrator of books, many of them for children


