
DWP Latest Updates

- JCP opening hours have now changed to accommodate the most recent social distancing and lockdown measures. JCP offices will be open from 10:00am – 14.00pm for vulnerable customers needing additional support, this is a drop-in service.
- Kickstart Employers are no longer required to offer 30 vacancies to be eligible for the scheme, there are
 no restrictions on how many vacancies they can offer, this change comes as employers reported this as
 being a barrier to access the scheme
- The Cabinet Office will soon announce their plans to recruit Disability and Access Ambassadors to advocate on behalf of JCP customers living with disabilities, who are both in and out of work, across a variety of sectors More news to follow!
