

# Westminster 20mph Limits



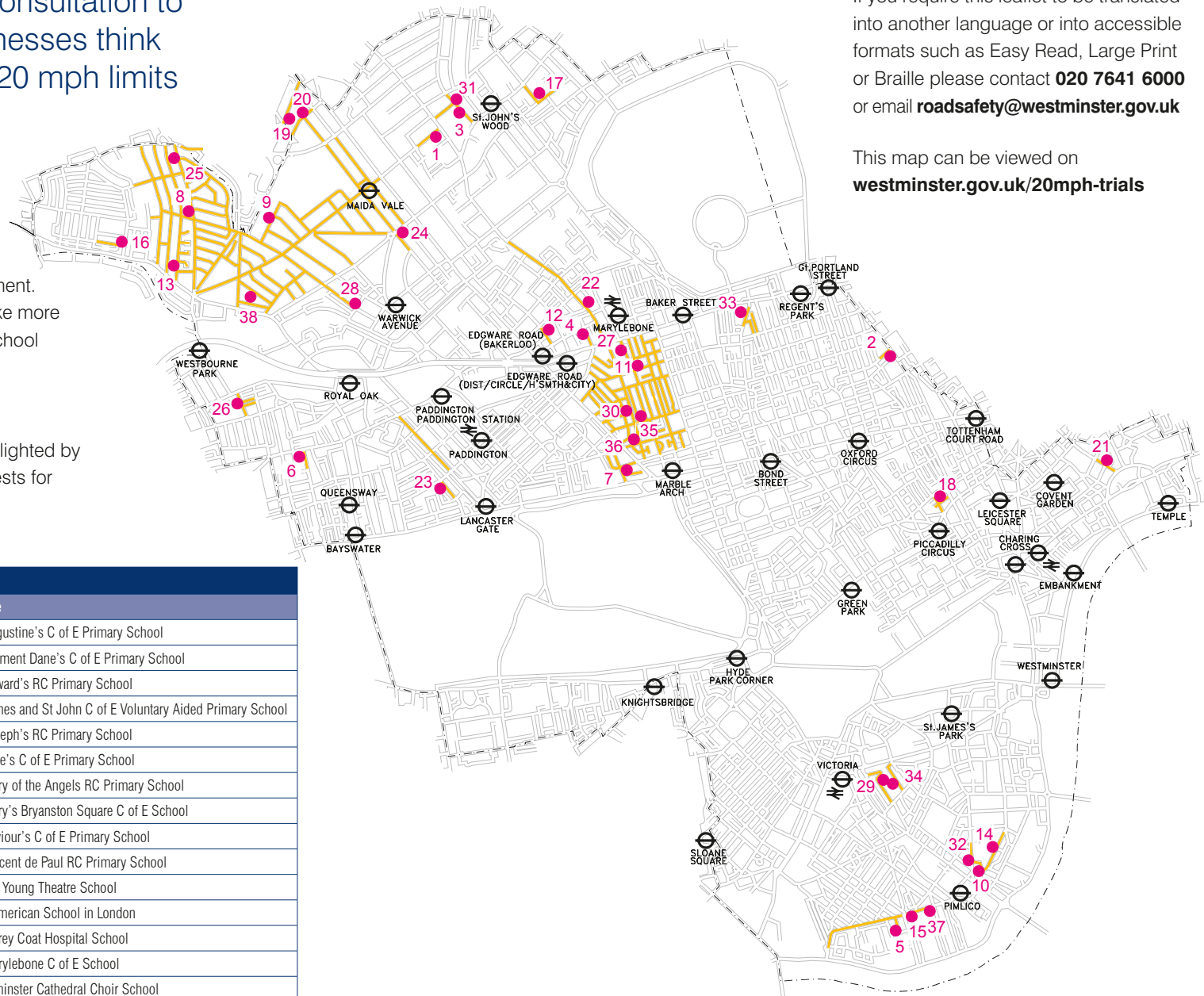
The Council is carrying out this consultation to find out what residents and businesses think about our proposal to introduce 20 mph limits in Westminster.

### Why introduce a 20mph limit in your area?

20mph speed limits are being introduced at up to 40 schools and across some residential areas over the next year. This trial is part of our drive to create a safer, healthier and more pleasant environment. The aim is to increase walking and cycling, and to make more vulnerable road users like cyclists, older people and school children feel safer.

### Locations

The 20mph limits are being implemented in areas highlighted by a road safety review and as a result of residents' requests for speed restrictions.

## Monitoring and evaluation

To evaluate the 20mph limit, we'll be gathering data about the speed and volume of traffic, using standard tubes laid across the road, as well as Vehicle Activated Signs (VAS).

VAS also remind drivers and riders to adhere to the speed limit. If motorists are going too fast, the VAS signs can be set to flash at either 20 or 30mph. Local schools, businesses and residents views will also be sought before, during and after the 20mph trials. This will help us understand their impact and inform our next step.
