A LOCAL LETTINGS PLAN FOR 300 HARROW ROAD

Many people will have seen that 300 Harrow Road is nearing completion. As part of our commitment to creating a Fairer Westminster, we're making sure eligible local people have the opportunity to benefit from the new council homes for social rent.

Through a local lettings plan, we can ensure priority will be given to those that live close to the development and are on the housing waiting list. These residents will receive further communication from our Housing Allocations team and will be eligible to bid for the newly completed homes. The scheme will be 100% affordable, with 77 new homes for social rent.


LANDSCAPE UPDATE
