DEMOLITION UPDATE

e are pleased to announce that we have completed the demolition of the former Westmead care home. We will now be moving on to the next phase of the construction activitity which will involve seperating the demolition waste, removing the ground floor slab and foundations and then piling works.

What does crushing involve?

Crushing works uses machinery to create heaps of reusable material that can be used as a working platform for the construction plant. Be assured that we will continue to monitor noise, dust and vibration levels, mitigating disruption as much as feasibly possible. Certain construction activities generate more noise than others, but we expect as activities complete things will quieten down as the build progresses.

MINIMISING DUST AND DISRUPTION

e are aware that there are some concerns from local residents regarding dust and noise during the demolition. We have been working with Westminster's Environmental officer to take the necessary steps to mitigate these concerns. Willmott Dixon Ltd are currently using a mist jet spray machine which is in constant operation when there is activity on site. The water system cannot be kept on overnight as they require a generator to supply the power however the team have been working diligently to manage the dust.
