We will not take action if you contact us and we can agree a payment arrangement – and you keep to it – or if there are exceptional circumstances which you have explained to us and we agree a recovery hold is appropriate.



## Reminder

We have sent you a reminder because you have not paid the instalments detailed on your bill. If you want to keep your instalments, you must pay the amount shown on the reminder within seven days and then pay the remaining instalments promptly when they are due.

If you do not pay the missing instalment within seven days, you will lose your right to pay by instalments and the full balance will become due immediately.

## Final

If you have received a final demand notice, this is because you have failed to keep up to date with the instalments profiled and you have now lost your right to pay by instalment. If you do not pay the full balance as shown on the notice for the year you will be summonsed incurring costs payable by you.

### Summons

We have sent you a summons because you have not paid your instalments even after a reminder notice has been issued.

You must pay the full balance of business rates and costs shown on the summons before the hearing date. If you do, the matter will be marked paid. Failure to make payment as required will result in the Council requesting the Court to grant a Liability Order at the set hearing, resulting in further costs being added to your account.

The liability order allows us to take the following actions against you to recover the business rates you owe:

- We can instruct Enforcement Agents (bailiffs) to collect the amount you owe by taking your goods and belongings and selling them at auction. The Enforcement Agent (bailiff) will also charge you additional fees.
- We can take action in the High Court to make you bankrupt or place a limited company into compulsory liquidation.
- If the Enforcement Agents (bailiffs) cannot collect enough money or goods to settle the debt, we can ask the court to send you to prison.
