CONSTRUCTION WORK AT PARSONS NORTH IS WELL UNDERWAY

It is just over a year since we started work on the Parsons North site. We are pleased to say that since then a great deal of progress has been made.

Recent progress:

- ▶ The basement slabs are now in place and the structure of the basement car park is near completion.
- ➤ The site is no longer powered by electrical generators, as the electricity supply from UK Power Networks has been turned on. This will improve air quality and will reduce noise output overall.
- ▶ Work has started on the concrete frame of the building and is due to be complete in May.
