Trade Union Facility Time Report – Education Function April 2020



Further to the Local Government Transparency Code and the Trade Union (Facility Time Publication Requirements) Regulations 2017, the council is required to publish information on trade union facility time. The following includes details of the total number of staff who are union representatives, the names of trade unions represented in the Council, percentage of time spent on facility time, and percentage of pay bill spent on facility time.

Trade Union Facility Time

As at 1st April 2020 Westminster City Council has a total number of 9 members of staff (schools) who are elected as Union Representatives, including general, learning and health and safety representatives.

The council has 2 union representatives that devote at least 50% of their time to trade union duties, and 7 elected representatives who, through the council's facilities time agreement, have the possibility to work up to a maximum of 15 hours per month, subject to agreement.

The Council recognises the following trade unions:

However, as in line with the required membership levels, as per the facilities time agreement, Unison, GMB and the NEU are currently the only unions afforded with a branch post. For the purposes of this report however, we are only reporting on school based employees.
