

ENTERPRISE HUB FOR LOCAL PEOPLE



ou may not know that the area on the ground floor at 300 Harrow Road is going to include brand new space for local creative businesses and entrepreneurs.

Opening in Summer 2024, the space will offer affordable rates (for those who need it) and a variety of spaces suitable for microbusinesses as well as more established enterprises. This will create an ecosystem of collaboration and support where the more experienced business owners will support start-ups to grow through mentoring and skill sharing. The enterprise hub will also offer opportunities for young people through apprenticeships and work experience.



GREEN LIVE LEARNING

GREEN TECHNOLOGIES IN NORTH WESTMINSTER LEADING THE WAY

id you know that the new solar panels installed on the roof of the Warwick Estate in Little Venice, are one of the biggest rooftop solar panel project on social housing in Europe? Our Green Lab learners, a group of local North Westminster residents, have been learning all about photovaltic units and the technology that make solar power possible.

WCC Regeneration Team and Westminster Adult Education Services have been delivering talks that bring together family learning with real-life demonstrations of green technologies across three of the regeneration and construction projects in north Westminster.

We have had over 36 residents attending the sessions to learn about low-carbon technology, such as air source heat pumps and solar panels like the ones installed at 300 Harrow Road and the Warwick state.
