# INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF WESTMINSTER CITY COUNCIL (the "Authority")

#### Issue of audit opinion on the financial statements

- had been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014.

### Issue of audit opinion on the pension fund financial statements

In our audit report for the year ended 31 March 2019 issued on 18 July 2019 we reported that, in our opinion the pension fund financial statements of City of Westminster Council Pension Fund:

- give a true and fair view of the financial transactions of the pension fund during the year ended 31 March 2019 and of the amount and disposition at that date of the fund's assets and liabilities:
- had been prepared properly in accordance with the CIPFA/LASAAC code of practice on local authority accounting in the United Kingdom 2018/19; and
- had been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014.

## Conclusion on the Authority's arrangements for securing economy, efficiency and effectiveness in its use of resources

In our audit report for the year ended 31 March 2019 issued on 18 July 2019 we reported that, on the basis of our work, we were satisfied that the Authority put in place proper arrangements for securing economy, efficiency and effectiveness in its use of resources for the year ending 31 March 2019.

#### Certificate

In our report dated 18 July 2019, we explained that we could not formally conclude the audit on that date until we had completed the work necessary to issue our Whole of Government Accounts (WGA) Component Assurance statement for the year ended 31 March 2019. We have now completed this work.
