Notice of Poll and Situation of Polling Stations

Neighbourhood Plan Referendum for the Mayfair Neighbourhood Area

1. A referendum will be held on **Thursday 31 October 2019** to decide on the question below:

“Do you want Westminster City Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Mayfair to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

2. The hours of poll will be from 7am to 10pm.
3. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, 14th Floor Westminster City Hall, 64 Victoria Street** by **5pm Thursday 31 October 2019**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 23 October 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service reasons, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 23 October 2019.
4. The situation of the polling station and description of persons entitled to vote there are as follows:
