Notice of Referendum

Neighbourhood Plan Referendum for the Mayfair Neighbourhood Area

1. A referendum will be held on 31 October 2019 to decide on the question below:

“Do you want Westminster City Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Mayfair to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

2. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, 14th floor, Westminster City Hall, 64 Victoria Street, London SW1E 6QP** by **12 midnight on Tuesday 15 October 2019**.
3. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, 14th floor, Westminster City Hall, 64 Victoria Street, London SW1E 6QP** by **5pm, Wednesday 16 October 2019**.
4. Applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, 14th floor, Westminster City Hall, 64 Victoria Street, London SW1E 6QP** by **5pm, Wednesday 23 October 2019**.
5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Electoral Services, 14th floor, Westminster City Hall, 64 Victoria Street, London SW1E 6QP** by **5pm Thursday 31 October**. If an application is made on the basis of physical incapacity, this physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 23 October 2019. If an application is made on the basis of work/service reasons, the applicant must have become aware after 5pm on Wednesday 23 October 2019, that he/she would be unable to vote at his/her polling station in person.
